# Time for a Swim!

The pool will be opening on May 25th and we are expecting a heavy turnout that weekend if the weather cooperates. As a reminder, the pool will be open from 10am-8pm Monday -Sunday with special hours near the holidays which will be posted. The pool deck capacity is 77 people with only 44 people in the water at any given time per West Metro Fire. Once we have reached capacity, we ask people to check back a little later to gain access. We are also asking residents to walk up to the pool if possible to save the parking spots. There will be safety checks every 2 hours to monitor the condition of the pool and allow a change in lifeguard's stations.

We will be utilizing the same pool software as last year. The system resets every year so all residents will need to register all members of their household prior to gaining access to the pool. CRS will verify addresses with our database to confirm accuracy of memberships submitted. Please include anyone who lives in your household or will be watching your children. Reminder, if your child is between the ages of 12-17 and can visit the pool without adult supervision; please sign the child release form in addition to the liability release when submitting the application. If you have renters, please have them stop by the Retreat Office to fill out additional forms.
